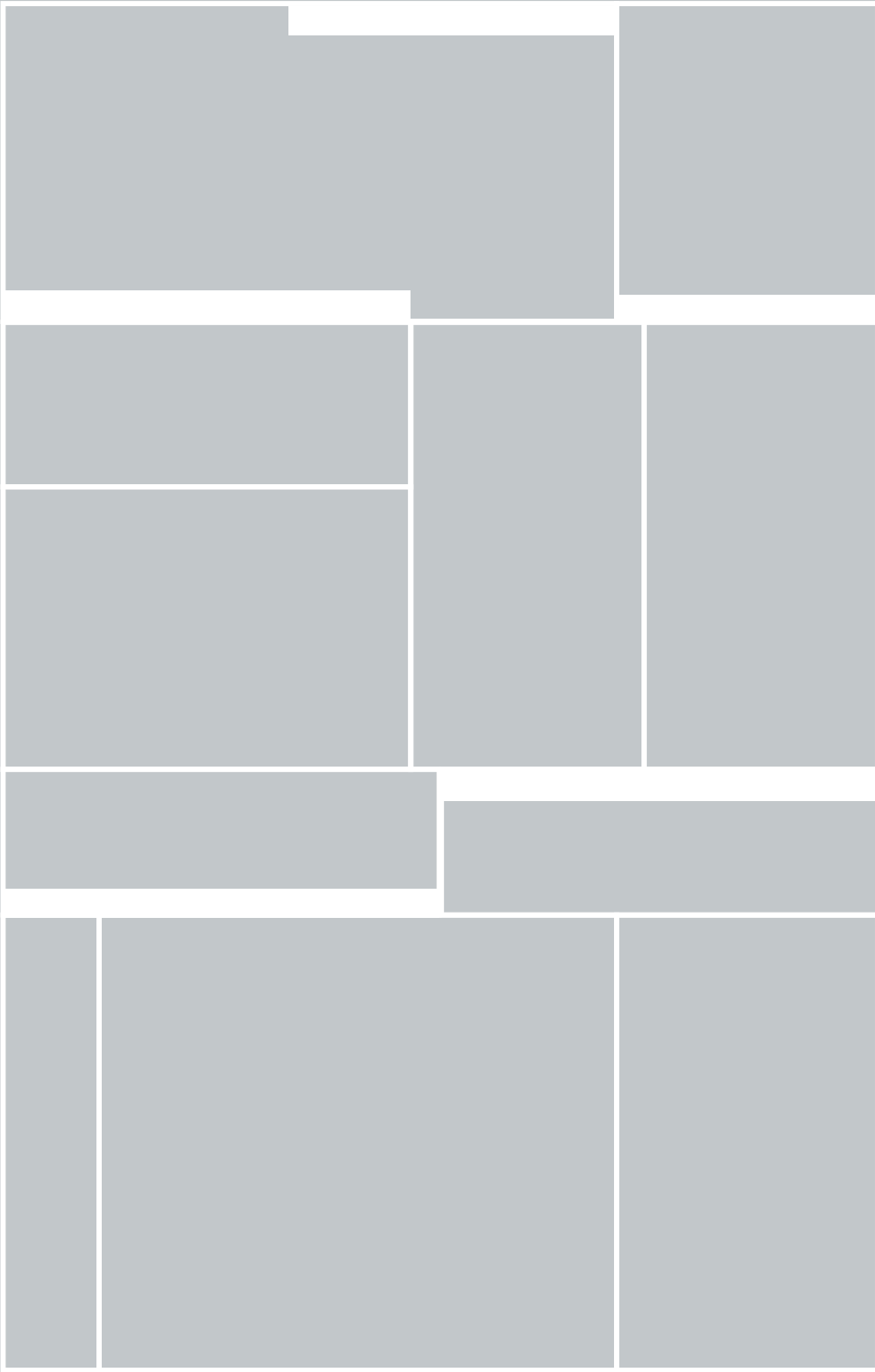
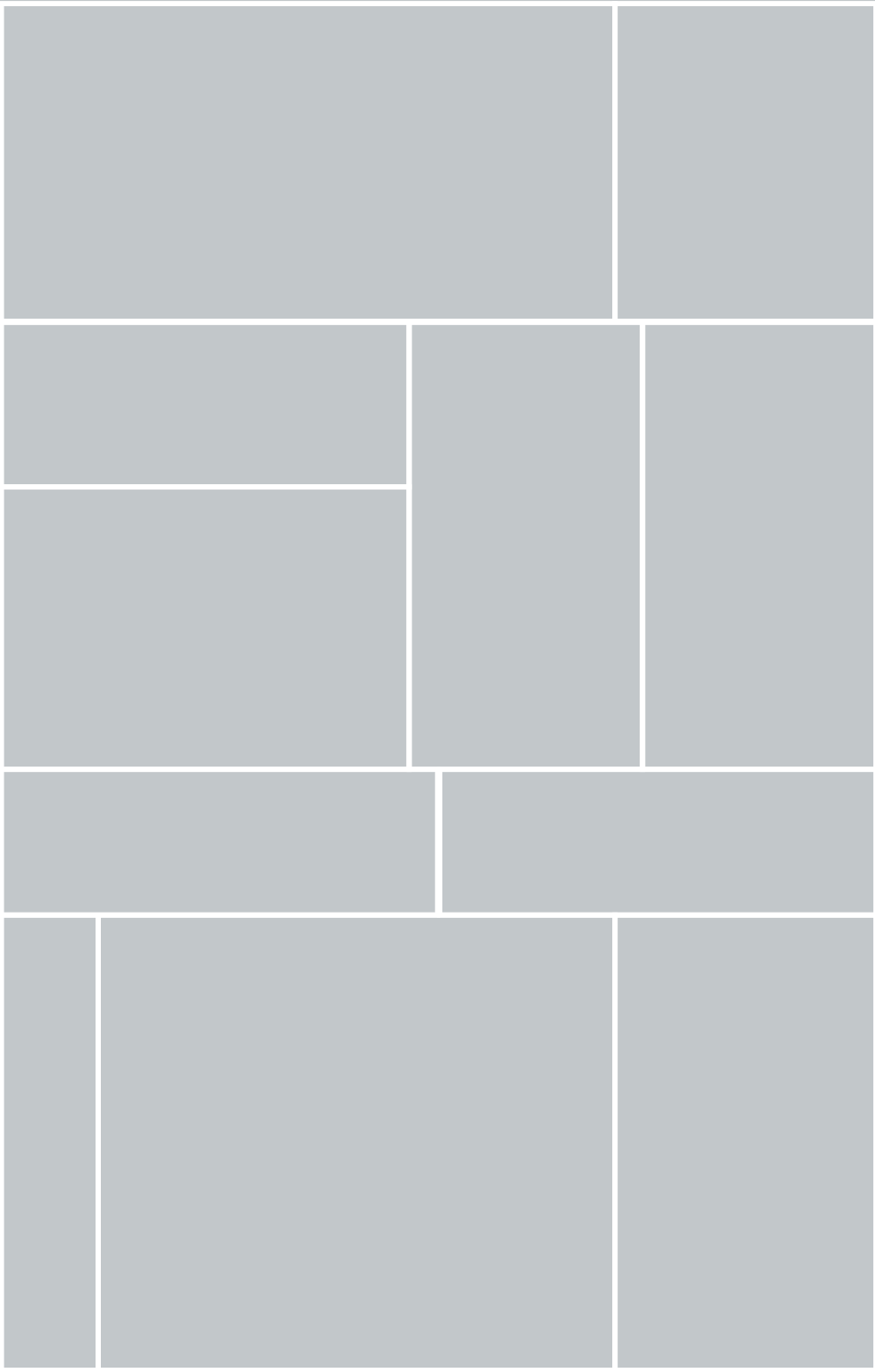

An architectural solution inspired by the Compositions of Piet Mondrian (1872-1944) that explores the balance of shapes and colors in the search for the perfect composition. This formal exercise is present in Casas de Santo Amaro resulting in an architectural style that reflects an aesthetic and a functionality that responds to the intention of creating a building solution with a timeless style — like a work of art.

Next to the river and an integral part of a city full of history, Alcântara is a unique, safe and welcoming area. Museums, iconic monuments, green spaces, shopping, culture, fashion, innovation and modernity embrace the authenticity and tradition that have remained intact here. An incomparable place, where tranquillity endures, but where life is paced by the diversity of one of the world’s most dazzling capitals.



# FIVE COMPOSITIONS

Five dwellings with independent access from an internal pedestrian path, which assume their singularity through walls, enhanced by their vertical cuts of the facade. The dwellings are developed on four floors with two private gardens: a ground floor with a hall, kitchen, social bathroom and a living room, with a view to the garden; a first floor with a suite, two bedrooms and a bathroom; a second floor — set back — with another suite, an office, a library and a terrace with jacuzzi; and finally, a basement with enough space to park three cars, cabinets and storage spaces. The project seeks to embrace the colours and materiality that are integrated in the city’s architecture. The foundation in bush-hammered lioz marble, the elevations in high resistance micro-concrete, the frames and the bronze lacquered laths, complemented by abundant vegetation materialise the compositions.

The project Casas de Santo Amaro consists of five houses, with four floors, parking and private gardens.

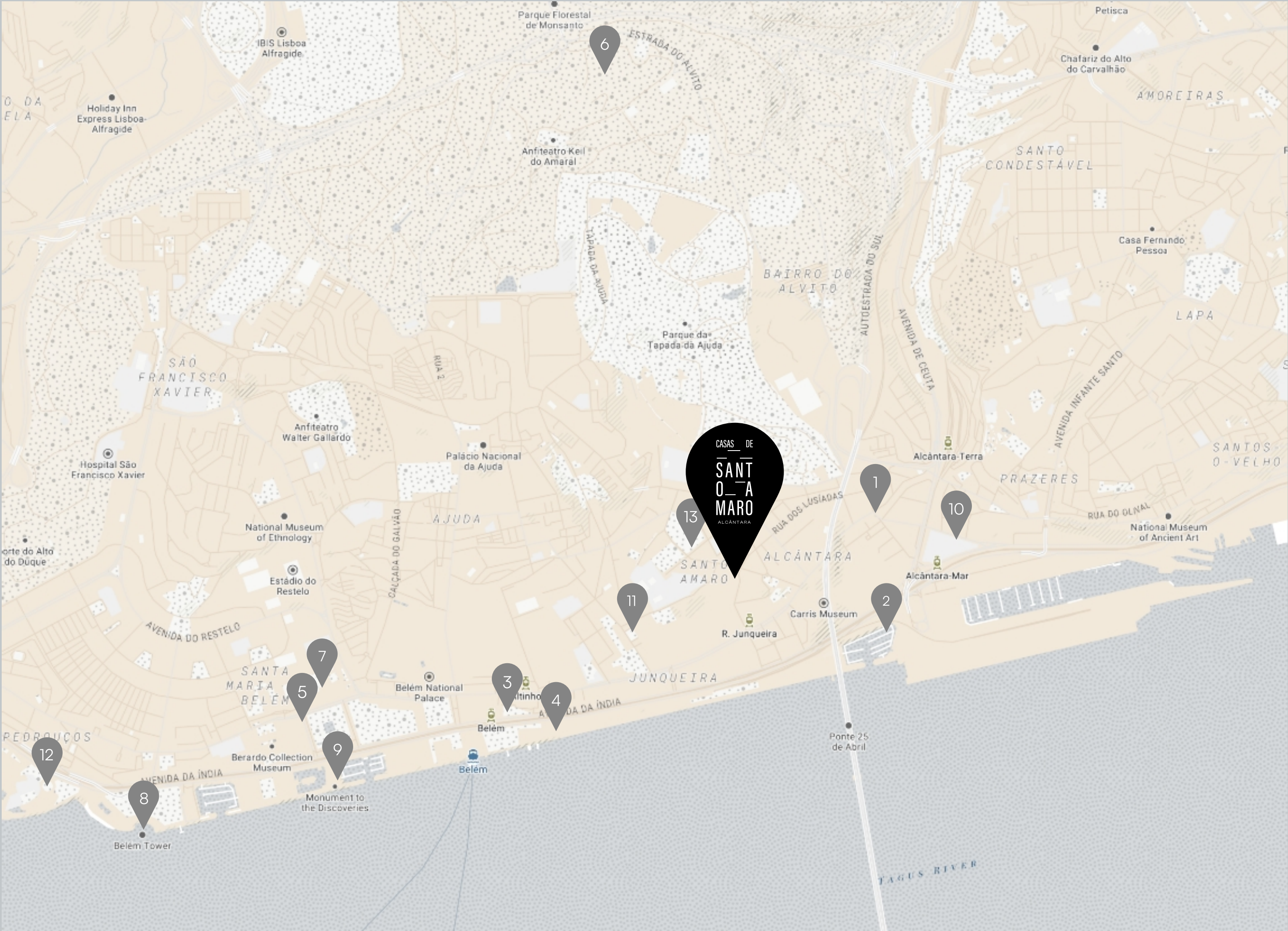
